RFP 2006-006-VC for the West Side Transit Improvement Study

The City of Albuquerque Transit Department, in conjunction with the Department of Finance and Administrative Services, Purchasing Division, issued the subject Request for Proposals for the West Side Transit Improvement Study on November 16, 2005. The successful contractor will provide planning services to the Transit Department to improve transit and pedestrian services on the City's West Side.

The City posted the solicitation on the purchasing web site, advertised in the Albuquerque Journal and the Albuquerque Tribune, and mailed the entire RFP to 38 vendors. Two bids were received. These were HDR Engineering and Parsons Brinckerhoff. Both are national firms with local offices that specialize in engineering, transportation and planning.


The ad hoc review committee unanimously recommended that the contract for the West Side Transit Improvement Study be awarded to Parsons Brinckerhoff. The scores for the proposals are listed below in rank order along with the bid amount for each. All bidders were awarded 50 points to committing to participate in the Summer Youth Initiative.

Firm	Score	Bid Amount
HDR Engineering	4741	\$64,549.00
Parsons Brinckerhoff	5335	\$14,985.68

The total amount of the contract will be subject to negotiation, but will not exceed \$15,000. The contract term is for 45 days, beginning at the execution of the signed agreement.

Per the City Purchases Ordinance, this recommendation will not require City Council approval.
